JUDITH TIFFANY: I want to support the bridge with the light rail going across. One thing about the bridge, the I-5 corridor, this is the only lifting bridge in the whole system. This is a massive corridor transportation area. We should not be having a lifting bridge in the middle of the freeway.

Also, it would be really nice to be able to walk or take a bicycle across the bridge, which is not possible at the present time.

Along with the new bridge, there will actually be a side area so that if somebody stalls out, they could be pushed over to the side instead of closing the whole bridge down.

And I want to talk about having light rail go to Vancouver. I really resent the fact that people who don't take public transportation think that only the criminal element ride the MAX. People that work hard all their lives take two hours to get to work and two hours to get home, work in places that serve these people that think that they don't need light rail. They need to think about it because, you know, people who work retail and service cannot afford cars.

And why do we need any more cars on the road anyway?

I think that we need fewer cars on the road and more mass

transit. Everywhere in the world they have mass transit to

get people to work. People do not take their car, one person in a car, drive it to work, have to be provided with a parking space for it all day long and then drive it home. It's just ludicrous. We should have public transportation. People do not need to have their cars sitting at work all day or paying \$4 a gallon for gas.

I also think that for safety reasons, the information -- the connection between I-5 and 500 will be really nice to have that changed because there is a middle school there. And at the present time, cars get off the freeway to go onto the next freeway and the kids have to cross that street where those cars are going by, and it's very, very dangerous. I used to live near there, so I know that.

I just think that -- the other thing I think is that the people who worked on this project, all the people have put a lot of time and effort into it. They don't have an agenda. They just want to do the very best thing for this community as possible. And for people to come in and say do they have an agenda, that there is -- it's -- it would be impossible. How would they have an agenda? How would they make a profit off of it? It's just --

What we need is to support the Columbia River
Crossing team. They've put a lot of hard work into it. They
know what's going on. And if you keep track of what's going
on, you would know what's going on, too.
