I AM ABSOLUTELY AGAINST TOLLS ON THIS PROJECT. I BELIEVE ONLY A FEW WILL BE TARGETED AND BEAR THE BURDEN OF PAYING TOLLS. THOSE AFFECTED WILL BE WASHINGTON RESIDENTS, VANCOUVER DOES NOT HAVE A JOB BASE OF LIVING WAGES, SO MANY MUST COMMUTE TO PORTLAND IN ORDER TO FIND LIVING WAGE JOBS. OREGONIANS WILL CONTRIBUTE A VERY SMALL PERCENTAGE TOWARD TOLLS. IN ADDITION, I AM TOTALLY AGAINST ASSESSING TOLLS ON I-205.
