I support the idea of using tolls on the existing bridge to encourage the use of existing mass transit. While this may be taken at an exploratory level to provide a clear picture of the type and volume of traffic that would use a very expensive replacement bridge, it may be possible this action would ultimately be the solution to the congestion problem.
