There is a possibility that the bridge over North Portland Harbor could include iconic design elements or vary in bridge type from the main river crossing. However such a design would have to be balanced with other considerations, including the potential increased cost associated with a high-profile bridge over North Portland Harbor and the desire to have an integrated structure with a free-flowing design. The construction of two significantly different bridge types would likely detract from the overall visual quality of the project and may introduce incompatible elements to Hayden Island. However, the Portland Harbor does provide an opportunity to design a taller bridge element. Desgins for a suspension bridge, such as those of Santiago Calatrava, have been eliminated because of the constraints of the Pearson Field and Portland Airport.
