RE: Interstate 5 Columbia River Crossing Record of Decision Notice of Availability

To Whom It May Concern:

On December 7, 2011, the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration signed a record of decision for the Columbia River Crossing project. The signed document finalizes the environmental review process, formally identifies the federal agencies' selected alternative for the CRC (a replacement Interstate 5 bridge with light rail) and allows final design and construction planning to proceed.

Enclosed please find the Notice of Availability for the Columbia River Crossing project record of decision. The notice is published to inform interested parties that the record of decision has been signed and how to access it. You are receiving this letter because you commented on the CRC Final Environmental Impact Statement.
