Q: Do you need a barge for this work, is it in shallow water, or on the shoreline.

A: Work is in the River

Q: How many piles and what is their purpose:

A: Six piles. Contractor is to furnish, install and remove the piles as well as bubble curtains. The purpose is for the contracting agency to perform hydroacoustic research during the contractor's work.

Q: What size are the piles?

A: 24" and 48".
