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Subject: Test Pile Question
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I received a call from Curt Ward with Advanced American Construction this morning at 8:32am. Here are the 3 questions that Curt asked:

1. Q. Is the air manifold system to be designed by the contractor since there are no sizes specified on the plan sheet (ND4 – 8 of 12). A. I told Curt that the air distribution setup is to be designed by the contractor (I verified this with James Schufreider – the mechanical engineer who did the design).
2. Q. Why do you have the contractor designing a confined and unconfined bubble curtain, when is it going to be determined which one will be used for the work? A. Both the unconfined and confined will be used during the contract to determine the level of attenuation that they provide.
3. Q. The plans state that someone else is going to take control of the system after the contract? A. The bubble curtains and manifold will become the property of WSDOT after the contract is completed.

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
