I-1041-001 Please do not carry through on plans for 520 expansion to six lanes through the Arboretum! We need to create plans for more mass transit across the Lake Washington. I am aware that the 520 and Alaskan Way are linked to ST 2 in an all-or-nothing ballot issue slated for Fall 2007, I request that neither the viaduct nor a tunnel be built on the waterfront, but that we implement transit service throughout the region.
