The structure is much too large (a 110 foot bridge!), destroys delicate wetlands along Union Bay as well as parts of the Arboretum, adversely affects access to the UW Hospital and UW Sports Complex as well as Children's Hospital, generates enormous traffic problems for the already jammed roads around University Village and the Montlake Bridge, and it will ruin views while creating noise and air pollution in the heart of vital Seattle neighborhoods.

**I-0490-002** | Please do what you can to see that this irresponsible and disastrous option is rejected in favor of replacing SR 520 with a 4-lane plus dedicated transit-way. Our region cannot handle this massive and disruptive project and the additional vehicle traffic it would allow.
