I-237-001 I work Downtown and have always thought that the current Viaduct is not only an eyesore, but unsafe as well. It's got narrow lanes, short sight lines and lousy offramps. The Tunnel option, while the most invasive choice, will open up the waterfront views for the buildings (condos and businesses alike) closest to the area as well as the views of downtown from the Waterfront. It also appears to add additional greenery and possibily pedestrian areas to the waterfront. I think that this will improve the overall impression of two of our most popular tourist areas - the waterfront and Pike Place Market. I note that there is some concern over the loss of views from the Viaduct if the elevated roadway is removed.
