Its replacement should include: Mass transit and high-occupancy lanes (HOV); Mass transit hub, interchange, and HOV lanes that link with other transit options (i.e., the Sound Transit station); A hub and interchange situated where large numbers of commuters gather (e.g.: University of Washington campus and UW Hospital), not a residential neighborhood.
